Mkomazi National Park is a hidden gem! The spectacular landscape of Mkomazi is home to all the Big Five as well as a range of species rarely seen elsewhere in Northern Tanzania, wild dogs, lesser kudu, gerenuk and oryx among them. Birders will find paradise, with around 400 species recorded, including five endemic ones.

The most fascinating experience in Mkomazi NP is undoubtedly a visit to the Rhino Sanctuary, where these impressing animals can be spotted at close range.
